





Selah School District Announces Superintendent Finalists

Six Candidates Selected for Preliminary Interviews

In its search to find Selah's next leader, the School Board of Directors has selected six candidates for preliminary superintendent interviews. These interviews are scheduled for Monday, March 28, and Tuesday, March 29, as an open-public meeting at the Selah School District Board Room. The six preliminary candidates are:

- Justin Irion, Assistant Superintendent for the Zillah School District;
- **Kelly Kronbauer**, Executive Director of Student Services and Operations in the Ellensburg School District:
- Kevin McKay, Former Sunnyside School District Superintendent;
- Dr. John Parker, Director of Innovation and Technology at Colegio Nueva Grenada (Bogata, Columbia);
- Tavis Peterson, Assistant Superintendent for the Wapato School District;
- Troy Tornow, Assistant Superintendent at ESD 123.

On March 28, the interview schedule begins at 4:00 p.m. Four candidates will be interviewed in one-hour sessions. On March 29, two interviews will be held beginning at 5:00 p.m., again for one hour each, then the Board will adjourn to executive session. At the conclusion of the preliminary interviews up to three candidates will be selected to visit the District on Tuesday, April 12, Wednesday, April 13, and Thursday, April 14. The final interview process includes the candidates meeting with staff groups and community members, as well as participating in a session with the Board. More information about the finalist interview process will be available on the District website on April 1.

It is expected that the announcement of Selah's next superintendent will be around April 15, with their tenure to begin on July 1, 2022.
