...THE B&O TAX CREDIT INCENTIVE PROGRAM IS OPEN FOR ENROLLMENT



A business must be registered to file its state excise tax return(s) electronically in order to take advantage of the tax credit and may do so any time prior to applying for the credit. Go to the Department of Revenue's (DOR) website: www.dor.wa.gov and locate the "I want to..." menu and click on the "File taxes online" hyperlink. Once a business is registered, they will be able to apply for the tax credit electronically through the DOR website.

Does a business need to reapply yearly for the tax credit each year?
