

Key Dates & Deadlines

- January 9th 8:00am MSTCIP applications open, and are non competitive until March 31st 5:00 pm.
- April 3rd 8:00am second quarter applications open, and they are competitive.
- November 1st contributions must be received at the SDA

How does a business request the credit?

A business must be registered to file its state excise tax return(s) electronically in order to take advantage of the tax credit and may do so any time prior to applying for the credit. Go to the Department of Revenue's (DOR) website: <u>www.dor.wa.gov</u> and locate the "I want to..." menu and click on the "File taxes online" hyperlink. Once a business is registered, they will be able to apply for the tax credit electronically through the DOR website.

Does a business need to reapply yearly for the tax credit each year?


