UPDATE FROM THE YAKIMA TRAINING CENTER: PFAS REMEDIATION

Community Leaders,

I am reaching out from the to give you an update regarding the various efforts the Yakima Training Center is currently working in support of PFAS remediation. We will be issuing a Quarterly PFAS newsletter that will go directly to the residents affected outside of our gates. Attached is the first edition which aims to answer many of the frequently asked questions we get from folks, and provide additional information on future our efforts.

Currently we are working to install Point of Entry Treatment (POET) filtration systems in all of the homes that are receiving bottled water (all the homes that tested above 70 parts per trillion for PFAS). Last week we conducted pre-construction meetings with the 13 residents who will be the first to receive POET systems. The next step in the process is finalizing the “Rights of Entry” paperwork. This paperwork is needed to ensure that the Army will be able to monitor and maintain each system moving forward – visits will still be coordinated with home owners. We anticipate construction to begin this fall as systems become available from the manufacturer.

After installation, the Army will test and monitor each system to ensure they are filtering out PFAS and assess when filtration media needs to be replaced. If residents have issues with their system we will be there to assist. Our process is slower than we would like but it is deliberate; we know the POET systems work and we will test them continuously to ensure that.

Additionally we continue the Remedial Investigation which looks to determine the size and scope of the PFAS issue both on and off post. A U.S. Geological Survey team is also conducting a study to better understand the complex hydrology of the areas on and around YTC.

YTC is planning to conduct a community event on **30 August** at the Selah Civic Center to help inform residents on the progress being made, and I will ensure to pass along the details as the event gets solidified. As always please reach out to me with any questions/issues, and I have Cc'd our new Public Affairs Officer, Mr. Paul Noel, who is also happy to assist.

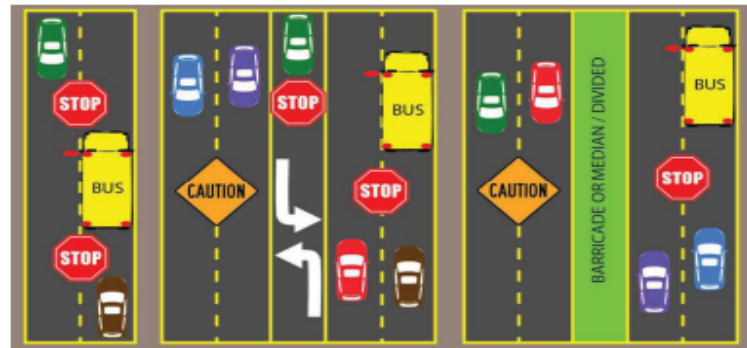

A Reminder of When to Stop for a School Bus

Student safety is the top priority of all school bus drivers. The law stipulates motorists must stop when the red paddle is extended. However, depending on the amount of lanes on a road, which direction a driver is traveling, and if dividers are present, determines which motorists need to stop. The basic idea is a bus only controls the lane it is in and the first lane to the left of the bus. Washington State law explains motorists must stop for a school bus that is stopped with its red lights flashing whether it is on your side of the road, the opposite side of the road, or at an intersection you are approaching. After the school bus red lights have stopped flashing, watch for children, and do not proceed until they have left the roadway. In Washington, motorists are not required to stop for a school bus with red lights flashing when the stopped bus is traveling in the opposite direction on the roadway and: has three or more marked traffic lanes, is separated by a median, or is separated by a physical barrier. **See diagram above.**



TWO-LANE ROAD
 All vehicles traveling in either direction must stop.

THREE OR MORE LANES, OR TURN LANE IN MIDDLE
 All vehicles traveling in the same direction must stop. Vehicles traveling in the opposite direction can proceed with caution.

ROADWAY THAT IS DIVIDED / MEDIAN / ISLAND
 All vehicles traveling in the same direction must stop. Vehicles traveling in the opposite direction can proceed with caution.
